NOTES

- Medals for all junior events, and senior / masters events with two or more entries
- Single entries will automatically be promoted to the next status
- Doubling up is encouraged
- Should the event be oversubscribed entries will be capped
- Masters events will be handicapped if necessary
- Events other than those offered above will be considered (e.g. mixed events)
- Boating for each division will commence immediately after the coxes / scullers meetings
- Time penalty – 10 seconds will be added if not through Altrincham Road Bridge 10 minutes before the race start
- Events may be run across divisions, however where possible the divisions above will be adhered to
- Trafford RC reserves the right to adjust the schedule if required
- Held under British Rowing Rules of Racing and Water Safety Code. PLEASE NOTE - only half a crew and the coxswain may be substituted once entries have closed. Substitutes must be a member of the same club, or clubs in the case of a composite crew, as the oarsman they are replacing (Rule 2.3.4b)
